

Has Your Application Been Waitlisted?

How It Works

- Wits received approximately 85 000 undergraduate applications for 2025 and will only be able to register or enrol approx. 6000 1st year students.
- Faculties can only accept a certain number of applicants into each degree, i.e. enrolment targets have been set for each programme.
- Applicants who have been made offers have a limited time within which to accept an
 offer. If they do not do so, then the faculty will withdraw those offers and may then be
 able to consider waitlisted applicants.
- Waitlisted applicants will be considered based on their APS points. For e.g., if a faculty
 has waitlisted applicants with an APS score of between 40 43 APS, those with 43 APS
 are considered before those with 42 APS, 41 APS, and 40 APS.
- The faculty will also take into consideration the marks for faculty-specific subjects. For
 e.g., a waitlisted applicant with 67% for Matric Mathematics will be considered before a
 waitlisted applicant with 65% for Matric Mathematics.
- Decision-making is ongoing and you are advised to monitor the self-service portal daily https://self-service.wits.ac.za/
